## 2014-2015 Recruitment Update: UTA Faculty

The UTA McNair Scholars Program has extended its application period through **November 17**, **2014**. We would appreciate your support in recommending this program to your students.

The McNair Scholars Program assists eligible\* undergraduates to prepare for the PhD and careers in university research and teaching. Although the program is open to all majors, we especially encourage juniors and seniors (not graduating before December 2015) in STEM fields to apply.

Program benefits are numerous and include, among others:

- Opportunities to learn more about graduate school, research, and university teaching
- Participation in the McNair Summer Research Internship between the junior and senior years (interns work with a faculty mentor and receive a \$3,000 student stipend)
- A scholarship for three credits of independent study (related to summer project)
- Free GRE prep materials and instruction
- GRE fee reduction vouchers (50% off of General and Subject tests)
- Travel to undergraduate research (or professional) conferences and graduate schools
