Dr. Judith J. Carrier 2016 Scholarships* \$10,500 in Scholarships

The Women's Alliance of the Arlington Chamber of Commerce focuses on empowering and uniting women through business and community endeavors. Seven (7) \$1,500 scholarships will be awarded (6) from the Arlington Chamber Foundation and (1) from Medical Center Arlington. The Medical Center Arlington nursing scholarship will be awarded to a qualified candidate who meets the nursing scholarship criteria. The recipients must be **full-time female undergraduate students** currently enrolled in 12 credit hours for the Fall 2016 semester at the University of Texas at Arlington or Tarrant County College-Southeast Campus and pursue a course of study in any discipline. Students must also have successfully completed a minimum of 12 credit hours of course work at UT Arlington or TCC - Southeast Campus.

Applications must include the following:

1. A student essay detailing a career development plan in a particular course of study and how that acquired knowledge will translate into achieving career goals in the workplace or our community. The essay must also address how you can contribute to the continued growth and success of women by being committed to strengthening women as professional business, community, and civic leaders. Essay must be between 400-500 words maximum.
2. Two (2) school and community recommendations as defined on the Scholarship Application.
3. Copy of Online Student Transcript showing GPA & total hours completed and total hours currently enrolled in.

Scoring: The essay will be evaluated based upon content, originality and overall impression which is worth 80% of the total score value. The school and community recommendations are worth 20%.

Selection Process:

Members of the Women's Alliance of the Arlington Chamber of Commerce Scholarship Committee will review all applications received. The Scholarship Committee and the Executive Committee of the Women's Alliance will make the final selections for Chamber Board approval. The top applicants may be asked to interview with members of the Scholarship Committee and the Executive Committee of the Women's Alliance. The recipients and a guest will be required to submit a high resolution photo and attend the Annual Inspired Women Luncheon on November 4, 2016 where the scholarships will be presented.
