

The University of Oklahoma Physics Undergraduate Summer Research Program




REU Research offered in:

The program runs from May 29-July 31, 2018 A stipend of \$4500 plus housing and travel will be provided.



Research facilities include Laser Cooling, Precision Measurement Labs, Atom Interferometry, STM Lab, Molecular Beam Epitaxy Facility, Particle Detector Development Lab and Clean Room, High Magnetic Field Lab, and High Performance Computing Facilities



Applications received by February 12, 2018 will be considered in full. Late applications may be considered as space permits.
