The Department of Defense's cybersecurity DFARS 252.204-7021 Interim Rule, a prelude to the Cybersecurity Maturation Model Certification (CMMC), has been in effect since November 30, 2020. To qualify for new bids, or for subcontracting opportunities, small businesses must NOW be in compliance with this DFARS. However, many small businesses have yet to comply- which has the potential to disrupt your supply chain.
