

Race, Crime, Justice

Dr. Robert L. Bing III holds a Ph.D. in Criminology from Florida State University and an undergraduate degree in Sociology from the College of the Holy Cross. He was the founding chair of the Department of Criminology and Criminal Justice, where he served for twelve years and again as Interim Chair in 2015. His research interest includes race and criminal justice education, corrections, plea bargaining.

Dr. Bing will discuss his book , *Race, Crime, Justice.* The book recognizes the influence of politics; it also explores flawed policies and practices that contribute to the disparate treatment of minority group members. Dr. Bing will discuss the social construction of crime and demonization of people of color through the criminal justice system.
